ATERBASED

To create a screen printed t-shirt, Each colour in your design are seperated into individual screens. Coloured tees require a undercoat known as base print + artwork colour. We then place each individual screen over your garment to lay down each ink colour – the end result is your completed design. It's a bit more intricate than that, but you get the idea: more colours = more screens and more screens = a higher cost per print.

Our in-house screen-printing can print any combination of colours with any colour of T-shirt to your preference. We print across all mediums (discharge, water based, plastisol, GOTS certified organic, foiling or metallic, just to name a few options) and can complete your garments in super-fast turnaround times.

Screen-printing remains the industry standard and is used by 95% of our customers including Mountain Designs, Jeanswest, Sea Shepherd Australia, QUT, Noosa Longboards, Animals Australia, Edgards Mission & Monash University.

ADVANTAGES OF WATER-BASED INKS

Water -based inks are good choice when a 'soft hand' is desirable. A soft hand is the condition where the ink film cannot easily be felt with the hand when passed across the surface of the fabric. This affect is often used as a argument for why water-based is preferable to plastisol as plastisol has more of a hand than water-based.

ADVANTAGES OF PLASTISOL

Plastisol can best be described as a 'user-friendly' ink because it is very easy to manage. Plastisol can be left in the sun for extended periods of time without clogging the mesh. It is ready to use right out of the container more than 90% of the time.

In most applications, it can be printed wet-on-wet, which allows for increased production speeds. It comes in formulations that can be printed on light and dark fabric. And, in most municipalities, the disposal of waste plastisol is very simple process. This is the most economical form of screen printing

MORE INFORMATION & SURCHARGES RELATING TO SCREEN PRINTING

- 1. Screen set up = \$70/Colour. Set ups are kept for six (6) months and then disposed. This is to ensure quality reprints within the allocated time therefor after requires setting them up again.
- 2. Discharge print incur 50% surcharge on top of plastisol printing charges.
- 3. Metallic inks incur \$1.50 surcharge on top of plastisol printing charges.
- 4. Other types of printing options are available and priced upon request.

DIGITAL PRINTING.

Known as Direct-To-Garment (DTG) printing it is a method of printing multi-coloured artwork directly onto the garment. Unlike screen printing, you can go crazy with the number of colours/shades with digital printing without worrying about the number of set ups required. This method is best suited for low volume print runs with high number of colours.

DTF PRINTING

DTF stands for Direct To Film. This technique involves printing your design directly onto a film and then transferring it to a T-shirt made of cotton, polyester, or their blends, regardless of their colour, as it can work with white ink.



Here are the basic steps of DTF printing:

- 1. The design is printed onto a special transfer film with water-based inks
- 2. The ink on the film is then coated with a special adhesive powder
- 3. Then the design is transferred onto the fabric using a heat press



The embroidered patch is the most popular type of patch. It uses solid colors and vector or digitized designs and cannot use designs with tiny and intricate details. Moreover, it uses a special embroidery thread which is either polyester, rayon, or a blend of the two. The result is a textured patch with a 3D look. Text size should be at least 3.5mm.




WOVEN PATCH - OVERLOCKEDEDGE

Woven patches use finely detailed multi-colored designs. Depending on the actual artwork they can often achieve finer and smaller details than embroidered patches. They use thinner threads with no base which creates a smooth surface and appears flatter and thinner than embroidered patches.



LASER CUT EDGE

Also known as hot cut edges, they are the choice for patches that have unique shapes and more complex designs. However, they are more suitable as Iron on and not sewn on in most cases.



SUBLIMATED

Sublimated patches offer unmatched design flexibility, allowing vibrant and durable images by printing directly onto twill fabric. With no limits on color or letter size, they accurately reproduce intricate artwork and photos. This adaptability has made them popular across various uses, from sports uniforms to promotional and personalized clothing.



CHENILLE

Chenille patches, made from chenille yarn tightly woven into loops, create a unique 3D look with a fuzzy texture. They're commonly found on varsity jackets and cheerleading uniforms.



PVC

PVC patches, also called rubber or PVC morale patches, are crafted from polyvinyl chloride. They're molded to achieve intricate designs with raised and recessed areas, offering durability and easy maintenance. Preferred over traditional embroidered patches, PVC patches endure more wear and tear while being simple to clean.



If you choose to go with the neck transfer method, you can be as creative as you want, but make sure you have the following information in your design.

- 1. Branding.
- 2. Sizing.
- 3. Composition
- 4. Country of Manufacture
- 5. Care instructions (with optional icons)
- 6. Optional web address
- 7. Optional social media

POSSIBLE PRINT LOCATIONS

Below are some of the popular print locations. Based on this idea some of the location may be limited to what you can print on the apparel of choice (e.g. singlet, long sleeves, etc). Please bear in mind we are unable to print over seams and require at least 2.5cm gap tolerance from seam on all sides. E.g. we can't print edge to edge.





ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

We want you to have the best print result possible so it is important that we have great artwork files to work with. Vector based image such as made using Illustrator or Inkscape, either an .ai, .eps, .pdf file format is recommended. This format allows us to shrink and expand the artwork to suit the garment without compromising the quality of the image. If you are working with a pixel based image such as made using Photoshop or Canva, either a .psd, .pdf, .tiff, .png or jpeg format is recommended, as long as the artwork is in the size to be printed, and the resolution of at least 300dpi if possible to avoid any pixilation or bleeding.

CHECKLIST

- ✓ Please make sure fonts & lines have been converted to outlines.
- Please provide SOLID COATED PANTONE CODES for printing and/or EMBROIDERY THREAD COLOUR CODES for embroidery.
- ✓ Please ensure artwork is cropped to specided size and ready to print.
- Please ensure your artwork elements are all grouped together.
- ✓ Please do not send us the same colour image and background artwork files that look invisible when opened. Ie: a white on white artwork file.

When your artwork is print ready, please <u>email</u> the artwork it to your Sales contact if the <u>artwork is under 12mb</u>. If the artwork files are too large to email, you can share your artwork with us using the following file transfer options; Dropbox, WeTransfer, OneDrive, Google Drive..





The minimum production run from our Turkish factory is 500 pieces per style and colour, when using stock jersey fabrics, or 200 kg if the fabric is dyed to order.

For fabrics that have to be developed and knitted to order the quantities may be higher and are quoted upon application only.

Minimums on Earth Positive and Salvage fabrics, which are produced in Asia, start at 1500 pieces per style and colour.

Garment costing

All bespoke orders are quoted individually. Thus prices will vary depending on the exact garment spec and details requested (Fabric / Colour / Style / Branding etc).

Sampling cost

There is a charge for preparing and sending prototypes to cover our costs.

Labelling

We can manufacture printed or woven labels from artworks provided, and insert during production into the garments in a position of your choice

Custom colours

For custom colours, Pantone® Matching System reference or a colour swatch should be provided. Lab-dips are free but delivery from the factory is charged at cost. Turnaround is 4-6 days. A minimum dye lot is 200 kg for core plain fabrics. (This represents around 700 women's T-shirts in size M or 600 men's T-shirts in size L).

Screen / Digital and Sublimation printing at source – 'Panel printing' before garment assembly is a particular specialty, but all types of screen printing techniques are available.

Manufacturing takes place in the Earth Positive factory in India

Our Earth Positive Factory is the first clothing factory in south-east Asia to have received a platinum award LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Factory status. It is recognised as one of the best factories in the whole of India in terms of health and safety, labour standards, workers welfare and environmental protection practices

The ultra-modern factory, located in southern Indian countryside, opened with one production unit in 2012. Since then it has grown to five state-of-the-art production units.

The factory is powered by renewable energy generated from its own wind turbines, photovoltaic and solar panels.

Living Wage

Our living wage program called Fair Share means workers at the Earth Positive factory earn a negotiated industry wage that is above the legal minimum, and on top of that they receive a living wage premium as part of their monthly pay package.

Certified Organic

Organic cotton agriculture combines tradition, innovation and science for the benefit of the environment and to promote a good quality of life for everyone involved.

Detox To Zero

This program focuses on stopping harmful chemicals being discharged into water, soil and air during textile processing.

Our Earth Positive dye house operates a zerodischarge closed-loop wet processing. We test the wastewater and sludge to ensure conformity with the DETOX TO ZERO Manufacturing Restricted Substance List (MRSL) of prohibited chemicals.

This is currently the only facility outside of Europe granted the Greenpeace Textile Procurement Standard Letter of Compliance.
